**Subject: Notification of Closure per 40 CFR 257.102(e)(1)(ii) and (g): Nearman Creek Power Station Coal Combustion Residuals Surface Impoundment, Permit No. 0413**

Dear Ms. Coleman,

This letter serves as notification to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), Bureau of Waste Management, that the Kansas City Board of Public Utilities (KCBPU) is closing the Nearman Creek Power Station Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Surface Impoundment, Permit No. 0413 per 40 CFR 257.102(e)(1)(ii) and (g). It is anticipated that the last known amount of beneficial use material will be removed by the end of February 2020 to end of March 2020.

BPU submitted its notification of closure to KDHE on February 1, 2018, including the revised Bottom Ash Closure Plan dated November 2, 2018. The Construction Quality Assurance Plan (CQA) was also submitted of which KDHE approved on September 18, 2018. KCBPU will notify KDHE when CQA field activities commence.
