This letter has been prepared on behalf of Kansas City Board of Public Utilities (BPU) as required § 257.105(h)(8) and § 257.95(g) to provide notification to the Nearman Creek Power Station's Operating Record that arsenic has been detected at three wells within the Bottom Ash Pond groundwater monitoring well network at statistically significant levels above its groundwater protection standard. Groundwater protection standards were developed in accordance with § 257.95(h) as part of the assessment monitoring program being implemented by BPU.
